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Alleged starvation case continued to August 27

HOLDEN - The case of a Holden couple under investigation for allegedly starving one of their children was scheduled for arraignment on July 21 in Leominster District Court, but was postponed until Wednesday, August 27.

According to published reports, Kellie and Joshua Theriault of 1588 Main St. face charges of reckless child endangerment after their two-year-old was reported to the Department of Social Services as being bruised; investigators allegedly found the child underweight. He was hospitalized and then removed to foster care, and has gained weight since being removed from the home.

Local police and the Worcester District Attorney's have declined commenting on the case until the arraignment.

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
