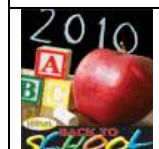

Church burglar sentenced

A Marlboro man charged with breaking and entering in Holden Chapel on Reservoir Street in Holden during Thanksgiving week 2008 has been found guilty.

Shad St. Pierre, 32, of 53 Elm St., Marlboro, was found guilty of breaking and entering at night, destruction of property, larceny from a building, vandalism of church property and larceny over \$250 at a trial in Fitchburg District Court on Sept. 28.

He was sentenced to two 2.5-year sentences and probation.

The charges stem from an investigation that began when Holden Chapel workers found doors broken in and cash and credit cards stolen from the church on Nov. 26, 2008.

Some of those credit cards were found in a vehicle driven by St. Pierre when he was stopped by police in Salem.

The investigation involved Salem and Holden police, the Worcester County Breaking and Entering Task Force and the New England State Police Information Network (NESPIN). — *M.M.*
