Men arrested after foot chase

Two Holden men are facing charges after they fled the scene of a motor vehicle accident at the corner of Main St. and Kendall Road on Monday and were pursued by police on foot.

Brian D. Alisch, 20, of 22A Princeton St. is facing charges of operating under the influence of liquor, reckless operation of a motor vehicle, leaving the scene of a personal injury accident and disturbing the peace after he and Anthony J. Coraccio, 21, of 108 Jackson St., left the scene of an accident.

Police say the vehicle driven by Alisch was heading southbound and hit a vehicle being driven by Jeffrey Hawley of Broad Street, Jefferson, which was heading northbound. Hawley sustained minor injuries in the accident.

Police responded to calls reporting the accident and the flight of two men from the scene of the accident about 6:30 a.m. Monday. They pursued the suspects on foot for a short distance. Coraccio, who sustained a minor injury in the accident, was treated by EMTs at the police station.

Coraccio also faces charges of disturbing the peace. - M.M.
