## Suspects jailed in home invasion

Two men have been jailed in the case of a daytime home invasion on Winfield Road in Holden on May 27 after an investigation by Holden Police.

Matthew McCourt, 27, of 10 Sterling St., Worcester, was arrested with the aid of Worcester Police just 12 hours after he allegedly entered the home of a Winfield Road woman whose purse had been stolen at her place of employment in Worcester the week before. Felix Alberto Nevarez, 33, of 10 Lincoln St., Webster, was arrested Sunday, May 30.

Holden Detective Al Bourget and Sergeant Rick Horrigan investigated the case.

The resident of the home on Winfield Road asked for extra patrols on May 22 after the theft of her purse, concerned that the thief would use her keys and knew she was away from home. On May 27, while she was at home around 11 a.m., she called police and reported hearing sounds that indicated someone had entered her home. A second call from a neighbor reporting suspicious activity at the home led to descriptions of the vehicle and suspect.

McCourt was arrested in Worcester around midnight on May 27. Police are charging both men with breaking and entering in the daytime for a felony putting a person in fear and larceny over \$250 for the items removed from the Winfield Road home.
