## Sept. court date after end-of-summer party

**HOLDEN**— Five teens were arrested early Thursday morning on Cranbrook Drive, after neighbors complained of a house party that was out of control.

When police arrived at 2:20 a.m., several teenagers were fighting, and a large crowd had gathered to watch, according to Holden Police Chief George Sherrill. Police called for backup from the state police and the West Boylston Police Department.

"It appeared to be an end-of-summer, heading-off-to-college party that got out of control," Chief Sherrill said. The owners of the house were not home, and will be contacted by police about the party, the chief said.

Although police did not have an estimate of how many people were at the party, "It was large enough for the neighbors to complain," he said.

Two teenagers were allegedly fighting when police arrived: Matthew Whitney, 19, of 7 Pheasant Hill Road, West Boylston; and Michael J. Cobill, 19, of 7 Kings Mountain Drive, also in West Boylston. Both were charged with assault and battery and being under 21 years of age in possession of alcohol. Mr. Cobill was also charged with destruction of property worth more than \$250.

Three other teens were arrested: Jason E. Feldman, 19, of 71 Adams St., Boylston, charged with disturbing the peace, being under 21 in possession of alcohol, and possession of an open container of alcohol; Michael Davis, 19, of 85 Pine Arden Drive, West Boylston, charged with disturbing the peace, being under 21 in possession of alcohol, and destruction of property over \$250; and Robert B. Munroe, 19, of 3 Sword St., Shrewsbury, charged with disturbing the peace and being under 21 in possession of alcohol.

Holden police Sgt. Timothy Sherblom, Officer Adam Porcaro and Officer Anthony Ribbens made the arrests. The teens will be arraigned in Leominster District Court Sept. 18.
