Woman, 81, hit by car while walking her dog

State police examine possible role of solar glare

HOLDEN— A pedestrian was seriously injured when a car driven by a Holden resident struck her on Redgate Lane at 9:30 a.m. yesterday.

According to Police Chief George R. Sherrill, the 81-year-old woman was walking her dog when the accident occurred.

The woman suffered serious head injuries. She was flown by medical helicopter to an area hospital.

The chief refrained from identifying either person until family members are notified.

A state police accident reconstruction team was investigating yesterday. Chief Sherrill said authorities are investigating whether solar glare played a part in the accident.
