Man, 58, dies in one-car accident

HOLDEN— An unidentified man was killed shortly before 9:30 last night when his car went out of control on Salisbury Street near Mark Circle, rolled over and slammed into a tree, police said.

Lt. Donald A. Ball said the 58-year-old driver was alone in a Volkswagen headed southbound toward Worcester when he lost control of the car. It rolled over with its roof ending up against a tree. The driver was dead at the scene, the lieutenant said. His body was extricated by the Fire Department and taken to the medical examiner's office at the UMass Memorial Medical Center — University Campus in Worcester, the lieutenant said.

The crash closed a portion of Salisbury Street for three hours and traffic had to be rerouted through side streets, Lt. Ball said.

Besides Lt. Ball, Officer Anthony F. Gribbon and Trooper Steven Marsh of the state police reconstruction team are investigating the accident.
