Break-in suspect nabbed in Worcester

Rutland man identified in case

RUTLAND— A Rutland man suspected in a series of house break-ins in the area was arrested in Worcester yesterday.

Keith J. Thompson, 39, of 50 Paddock Road, was arrested on a warrant sought by Holden police.

Mr. Thompson, a former Gardner resident, also is a suspect in crimes committed in Holden. Sgt. Richard E. Horrigan of the Holden Police Department said he could not discuss the cases because of the ongoing investigation.

No charges have been filed against Mr. Thompson by Holden police, according to the sergeant.

Gardner police last month obtained an arrest warrant for Mr. Thompson after he allegedly entered a Stop & Shop Supermarket, stole a cart filled with about 20 large cans of infant formula valued at \$347 and fled.

According to police reports, Mr. Thompson also is a suspect in some gas station robberies.

Detective Troy J. Chauvin is conducting the Rutland investigation.
